GOVERNMENT NOTICE

NATIONAL TREASURY

No. 226

31 March 2014

Notice is hereby given that the National Treasury stopped, re-allocated, transferred and allocated allocations in terms of section 18, 19 and 25 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2013 (Act No. 2 of 2013) as set out in the Schedule and the explanatory memorandum hereto.

Explanatory Memorandum to the Allocations set out in the attached Schedule

This notice is published in terms of section 18(3), 19(1)(b), 25(1) and 25(3)(c) of the Division of Revenue Act, 2013 (Act No. 2 of 2013), herein called "the DoRA". Section 25 provides that any transfers not listed in the Schedules may only be made in terms of section 6(3) which provides that additional allocations to provinces or municipalities may only be made in an adjustments budget and must comply with such monitoring and reporting requirements determined by the National Treasury. Further, section 25 also requires that the National Treasury must publish such allocations in the Gazette, prior to the transfer of any funds to a province or municipality.

Defer of MIG and INEP programmes

1. Section 18 of DoRA stipulates that the National Treasury may in its discretion or at the request of a transferring national officer stop the transfer for Schedules 4 and 5 pertaining to anticipated under-spending on programmes or allocations in the financial year by the municipality. Under-spending occurred in respect of the Municipal Infrastructure Grant (MIG) and the Integrated National Electrification Grant (INEP) by certain municipalities.
2. Following requests by the Department of Cooperative Governance (DCoG) and the Department of Energy, the National Treasury approved the application of section 18 (stopping of the allocation) and 19 (reallocation of the allocation) of the DoRA in respect of certain municipalities, while the funds of other municipalities will be stopped in order to allow spending until the municipal financial year end, 30 June 2014.
3. The National Treasury will therefore consider supporting these through the National rollover process. This will allow municipalities that have committed projects but are not spending in full by the end of the municipal financial year, an opportunity to continue spending on their projects in the next financial year.

Transfers from Schedule 7 Grants

4. Schedule 7 to the DoRA makes special provisions for the immediate release of funds to provinces and municipalities following declared disasters.
5. On 03 March 2014, National Treasury approved the transfer of funds amounting to R98.9 million from an unallocated Municipal Disaster Grant allocation following severe drought in the Northern Cape province and heavy rain falls and flooding experienced by the Western Cape province.
6. An amount of R50 million has been allocated to the Northern Cape province and R26.9 million has been allocated to the Western Cape province respectively.
7. Further an amount of R22.1 was allocated to two municipalities in the Western Cape province namely the City of Cape Town Metropolitan with R5.8 million and Breede Valley with R16.3 million.
8. Funds to these disaster affected municipalities have already been transferred. This gazette formalises the process as per the requirement of section 25(3) of the DoRA.

9. The DCoG is the national transferring department of this grant and will be responsible for monitoring the performance of this allocation through the National Disaster Management Centre.
