# The Integrated Development Plan - IDP




- The Integrated Development Plan (IDP) is to be used as the bases to strategically plan for future developments in the municipal area.
- Once the IDP is developed, all municipal planning and projects should be managed in terms of the IDP.

#### **Lessons Learnt**

- ✓ Project segment is linked to IDP through the KPI number
- ✓ All operational and capital expenditure will be aligned to the IDP
- ✓ The areas of responsibility are to be converted to the GFS Functions.
- ✓ The IDP will be linked to a funding source
- The budget will expand into capital and operational projects
- The project segment will link to the IDP through the KPI number



#### mSCOA Pojects



**Project** is a collection of tasks usually of a multi-disciplinary nature to achieve a certain goal; for example, the construction of a new road. A project can consist of only a single contract; for example, outsourcing a road construction to a single provider; or to numerous service providers together constituting a project, such as separate contracts with an electrician, own labour, and own material.



The DC12 Amatole paid contractors for fuel used when tarring a previously untarred regional road. The funding for the upgrade was property rates.
