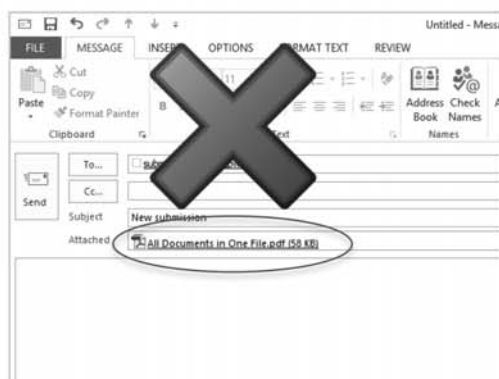

### NATIONAL TREASURY

**No. 258****26 March 2015**

I, Nhlanhla Nene, in my capacity as the Minister of Finance, hereby publish, in accordance with section 19, 20, 25 and 26(3)(c) of the Division of Revenue Act, 2014 (Act No. 10 of 2014), transfers of the Provincial Disaster Grant and stopping and reallocation of the remaining allocation for Municipal Infrastructure Grant and Municipal Water Infrastructure Grant.

## **Explanatory Memorandum to the Allocations set out in the attached Schedule**

This *Gazette* is published in terms Section 26 of the Division of Revenue Act, 2014 (Act No. 10 of 2014). Section 26 provides that any transfers not listed in the Schedules may only be made in terms of Section 6(3) which provides that additional allocations to provinces or municipalities may only be made in an adjustments budget and must comply with such monitoring and reporting requirements determined by the National Treasury. Further, Section 26 also requires that the National Treasury must publish such allocations in the *Gazette*, prior to the transfer of any funds to a province or municipality.

### ***Provincial Immediate Disaster relief funds***

1. Schedule 7, part A of the Division of Revenue Act provides for funds to be released immediately to provinces where provinces have declared disasters and successfully applied through the National Disaster Management Centre for funding. The Period for the release of funds range between 3 Days and 3 months.
2. According to section 26 of the 2014 Division of Revenue Act, the transferring national officer, which is COGTA, must notify National Treasury and the relevant provincial treasury within 14 days of the transfer to a province or municipality.
3. National Treasury must subsequently publish the allocation by notice in a gazette within 21 days of being notified.
4. On 22 May 2014, National Treasury approved the transfer of funds amounting to R9.5 million from the unallocated Provincial Disaster allocation to the Limpopo province following heavy flooding experienced by the province, and
5. On 8 January 2015, National Treasury approved the transfer of funds amounting to R10.2 million from the unallocated Provincial Disaster allocation to the KwaZulu-Natal province following veld fires in the Harry Gwala district.
6. Funds to these disaster affected provinces have already been transferred. This gazette formalises the process as per the requirement of section 26 (3) of the 2014 DoRA

### ***Stopping of MIG***

7. Section 19 of DoRA stipulates that National Treasury may in its discretion or at the request of a transferring national officer stop the transfer for schedules 4 and 5 pertaining to anticipated under-spending on programmes or allocations in the financial year by the municipality.
8. During the month of January 2015, the National Treasury conducted an analysis of the performance of the MIG. The quarterly publication (Section 71 of MFMA) published by the National Treasury and the Monthly Division of Revenue Act reports (Section 9 and 10 of 2014 DoRA) from the Transferring National Officers were used as a benchmark in deciding on the list of municipalities which were underperforming.
9. Letters dated 20 February and 04 March 2013 signed by Acting Deputy Director-General: Intergovernmental Relations were sent to municipalities in terms of

section 19 of DoRA informing them of the decision to stop a portion of their allocated MIG.

10. Municipalities were afforded an opportunity to respond within seven days on this decision and to explain why their grant funding should not be stopped.
11. Following the letters sent to the affected municipalities, the department of Cooperative Governance (DCog) had engagements with some of the municipalities with respect to their current expenditure to date for MIG in order to evaluate whether municipalities will be able to spend their entire transferred funds.
12. In light of the responses received from the municipalities and recommendations from Department of Cooperative Governance, the National Treasury decided that Section 19 (stopping of the allocation) and 20 (reallocation of the allocation) of 2014 DoRA will be invoked against certain municipalities and allow municipalities funds that they could spend until the end of the financial year, 30 June 2015.
13. The National Treasury will therefore consider the possibility of supporting some municipalities through the rollover process against municipalities that would have received additional funds. This will allow municipalities that have committed projects but are not able to ensure full expenditure by the end of the municipal financial year, 30 June 2014 an opportunity to continue spending on their projects in the next financial year.

#### ***Transfers from Schedule 6 Grants***

14. Further, the department of Water Affairs would like to reallocate the funds for the MWIG from one municipality to another. This movement is made between municipalities in the Free State, KwaZulu Natal, Eastern Cape and Limpopo. The MWIG is a schedule 6 programme which means that the stopping and reallocation will not affect the budgeting of the affected municipalities because funds allocated under schedule 5 are not transferred directly into the primary bank accounts of municipalities.
15. The Department of Transport responsible for administering the Public Transport Infrastructure Grant (PTIS) has made a request to correct errors made in the last adjustment gazette published on 31 December 2014 (Government Gazette No. 35375). The error corrects an amount of R2.5 million for Nelson Mandela Metropolitan Bay which was moved from the operations (PTNOG) programme of the to the Capital part of the grant (PTIS). An amount of R2.5 million will now be adjusted back to PTNOG as it was already transferred to the City when the adjustment was made.
